THE BRAVERMAN EYE CENTER Grand Opening of The Refractive Surgery Center

Normally, the Braverman Eye Center caters to patients, but on January 25th, more than a 100 people, mostly other eye doctors from Dade and Broward County, came to a grand opening of the new, state-of-the-art laser eye surgery center.

It was quite a party, with cocktails and catered food, but Dr. Stanley Braverman didn't see much of the food or drink – he was too busy showing off the only refractive surgery center with a LadarVision and CustomCornea within a 360 square mile area, stretching from downtown Ft. Lauderdale to downtown Miami and west to Plantation.

explain to the visitors how the LadarVision laser with CustomCornea uses space-age technology to create a three-dimensional map of each patient's unique visual errors that can guide the laser during the surgery. The machine also locks on the eye during surgery, using radar-tracking technology developed
